The Hydro Attack (the ultimate blend of shark and machine) can leap 18 feet in the air and then seconds later dive under the water, the adrenalin and excitement of a semi-submersible shark ride – just as much fun to watch as it is to participate – whatever else you've done in the name of extreme excitement, nothing, literally nothing, has prepared you for this. And this amazing machine will be docking alongside the Pacific Jemm to take you on the ride of your life.

Lots of things happen here from fast laps to go-karting. Go-karting is on a purpose built 650m outdoor track with karts that record your fastest time. The Highlands Taxi is a Porsche Cayenne Turbo, that promises a taxi ride like never before! reaching speeds you've never done before on the open road. Fast laps in the passenger seat of a Lamborghini Huracan (this is a buy in cost) – high adrenalin stuff! Plus Highlands is home to the National Motorsport Museum where you can see some of the rarest cars in NZ motorsport, there are over 30 cars on display here ranging from vintage to futuristic prototypes. Enjoy your time, relax and make sure you stop and take in the view at the picture window on the upper level the views truly are spectacular overlooking the entire racetrack area.

Tonight, sadly is our last night in Queenstown and what better way to end this fantastic experience, marvel at the stunning views as you ride the Gondola - the steepest cable car lift in the Southern Hemisphere, and one of the must-do activities in Queenstown! Sit back and relax as the best views in the region unfold before your eyes and the Gondola carries you 450 metres above Queenstown and Lake Wakatipu to the top of Bob's Peak.

The Luge is a thrilling ride for all ages and abilities and one of the top things to do in Queenstown. Jump on your specialised Luge cart, select your track, then zoom down the Luge tracks - you're in control. Then catch the Luge chairlift back to the start zone and do it all over again - once is never enough!

Then sit back, relax and enjoy a delicious buffet dinner sourced from fresh local ingredients and a glass of delectable local wine while you watch the paragliders drift past the window as the sun sets.
